### **ZOHAB ZEE KHAN**

### Workshops:

Switching from performer to facilitator, Zohab offers boot camp style workshops in self-development and poetry writing and performance designed to inspire change and confidence in young people by using diffused and focused thinking models aka brain hacking.

## **The Workshops**

# A: Small Boot Camp – only available after a performance.

This workshop utilises performance activities and writing exercises designed to teach and develop poetry techniques. The aim is self-expression, with students producing a performance piece by the end of the boot camp.

Suitability Years 5 & 6, Years 7 – 12.

**Cost:** Flat fee of \$450 (GST N/A) for a maximum of 35 students. **Duration:** 90 minutes for High Schools, 60 minutes for years 5 & 6.

Pens, paper and projector required.

# **B:** Big Boot Camp

The content of this workshop is similar to the Small Boot Camp (A) with more students attending but fewer doing the performance piece.

**Cost:** \$900.00 (No GST applies) for a Maximum of 100 students. **Duration:** 90 minutes for High Schools, 60 minutes for Years 5 & 6.

Pens, paper and projector required.

## **Zohab Zee Khan**

Zohab is a multi-talented spoken word poet, hip hop artist, proficient didgeridoo player and harmonica beat boxer.

Since 2006, Zohab has built a formidable career in spoken word poetry, culminating in taking out the title of the Australian Poetry Slam Champion in 2014. Zohab is the cofounder of the Pakistan Poetry Slam and has performed at festivals in over 20 countries.

Zohab's words have taken him to stages across Western Europe, South East Asia, China, Pakistan, and the Middle East. He has performed at the Glastonbury Festival. As a 4<sup>th</sup> generation Australian of Pakistani heritage and having being raised in rural NSW, Zohab has channelled his distinct life experiences into stories with the intent to educate.

In 2015 Zohab's collection of poetry "I Write" reached best seller status within 5 months of its launch.
