Using the same acronym as the first STAMP show, Let's STAMP Out Bullying combines all new magic tricks and stories to convey a simple, effective plan for dealing with bullies. Illusions and comedy are used to illustrate the 5 simple steps in this practical STAMP acronym.

The irrepressible Croc returns with an even more magical Drawing. No matter whether students have seen the first STAMP show or not, the strategies in the STAMP acronym are easily remembered and effective in dealing with bullies. This time around it is young Croc who is being bullied by a bigger meaner Crocodile who has taken over the swamp. However, when we finally meet this Crocodile, it becomes obvious that young Croc has not been telling the whole truth.

Drawn onto a sketch pad right in front of the audience, students are amazed when cheeky monkey starts moving her eyes and mouth, then speaking. Monkey is looking for a friend and when this drawing is torn from the pad and given to their new friend in the audience, everyone is baffled. How is that possible?
